

Church Family,

The following two verses of Scripture have captured my heart the past few weeks. Read these words of Jesus as He spoke to His first disciples and now as He speaks to us: "My Father is glorified by this: that you produce much fruit and prove to be My disciples" (John 15:8) and "You did not choose me, but I chose you. I appointed you to go and produce fruit" (John 15:16).

For the past month we have focused on the word LOVE during the morning messages. God loves us. We love God. And we are to love other believers as well as those outside the Church. Love is foundational to who we are as a Church. Now we turn our attention to the word GROW. We will grow in our faith as we love and produce fruit. Notice that Jesus said the Father is glorified when we produce fruit and that this also proves that we are His disciples. No, good works will not save us but we are saved for good works (Ephesians 2:10). Jesus has chosen us and appointed us to go and produce fruit.

I think sometimes we see the word GROW and the first thing we think of is numerical growth (and certainly we want that in the Church). Yet we need to GROW spiritually. We need to grow in spiritual wisdom and understanding. We need to grow in bearing fruit that brings glory to the Father. We have been appointed to this reality. I pray that you and I together will GROW and continue to see God do wonderful things in us and through us.

There are three specific events I want to highlight this month. First, on Sunday, September 9 at 5:00 there is a "Man Up" event hosted by Broadmoor Baptist Church in Shreveport. It is a free Catfish Dinner with a special guest speaker from Prestonwood Baptist Church in Plano, Texas. I want to encourage all of our men to attend. We will need to leave FBC at 3:30. Second, there will be a Church Life Night at FBC on Sunday, September 16 starting at 5:00. Every committee will meet on this night. Please plan on attending and being a part of this special night. Third, on Wednesday, September 26 people around the country will be gathering around flagpoles to pray for schools, communities, and the nation. I want to invite you to gather around the flagpole here at the church at 8:00 that morning as we gather together to pray for our schools, community, and the nation.

I am grateful to be your pastor! Let us pull together to LOVE - GROW - MULTIPLY here and around the world.

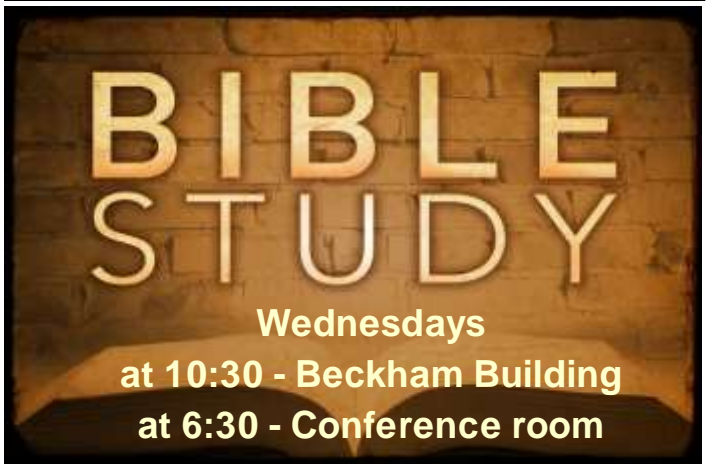
